Summer Term 2024

Year 1

Below we have outlined our learning for this term. The children will continue their outdoor learning every week, and enjoy our Forest School site.

As mathematicians we will:

- Develop our skills, knowledge and understanding of number and place value to 100.

- Learn to half and guarter a shape and an amount. Develop our knowledge of weight, mass and capacity. - Begin to multiply and divide by making arrays and splitting groups of objects equally.

- Learn to tell the time to the hour and half hour.

Vocabulary: number, value, hundreds, tens, ones, more, less, equal, greater than, less than, total, calculate, multiply, divide, time, half past, o'clock

As scientists we will:

- Work scientifically to ask and answer questions; make observations; identify and clarify, and gather and record data.

- Learn about trees and plants and identify the different parts of plants.

- Learn about evergreen and deciduous trees.
- Identify different wild and garden plants.

Vocabulary: observe, plants, flowers, petals, stem, roots, bark, trunk, leaves, evergreen, deciduous.

As readers and writers we will:

-Write our own version of a story based on Fatau Fetch the water by Neil Griffiths.

-Write a letter asking for environmental help after reading Stella and the Seagull by Georgina Stevens.

- Write the story of an adventure of a favourite toy after reading The Naughty Bus.

We will be using our knowledge of set 2 and 3 RWI phonic sounds to read a variety of real and nonsense words.

We will be focusing on spelling all of the Year 1 Common Exception Words correctly.

Vocabulary : story, text, structure, features, punctuation, vocabulary, clauses, noun phrases, sentence forms

In PSHE we will:

Follow the Jigsaw scheme and will cover the topics:

- Relationships
- Changing Me

Vocabulary: different, same, family, life cycle, change,

Develop our confidence, skills and movements in athletics and invasion games. Vocabulary: skills, movement, control, space, direction, defending, teamwork

As geographers we will:

-Develop our knowledge of the coast. We will look at both human and physical features of particular areas.

-We will locate our nearest coasts and identify where they are on a map. We will look at places where we may have visited the seaside.

-Identify both positive and negative impacts of people visiting and using the coast.

Vocabulary: human, physical, coast, pier, promenade, lighthouse, seaside, sand, aerial view.

As artists and designers we will:

-Improve our drawing skills, especially when drawing people, ensuring that we pay attention to detail.

-We will look at the artists Monet, Van Gough and Metzinger and recreate representations of their work.

Vocabulary: draw, sketch, landscape, pastels, colours, texture, line, shape, form
